Capital Area Teen Court is a Non-Profit Organization that serves youth from the ages of 9-17 with first time misdemeanor offenses as a redirection program. We handle real cases appointed by School Resource Officers, Police Departments, Juvenile Court and District Attorney's. Our program gives youth a second chance and allows them to go through the court experience with the help of volunteers from their peers and adults.

Please come out and volunteer with us!

- ⇒ **Judge**—Presides over Teen Court hearings; licensed attorney, law student (2L or higher) or sanctioned Wake County Judge
- ⇒ **Mentor Attorney**—Aids youth attorneys in preparing cases and provides constructive feedback on youth attorney courtroom performance
- ⇒ **Jury Monitor**—Sits with the jury to ensure all members are listening intently (not talking, giggling, or playing with electronics). Guides jury deliberation and ensures punishments are fair and just.
- ⇒ **Exit Interviewer**—Meets with offender and family after he/she has been sentenced. Exit interviewer reviews deadlines, consequences of failure, and skills group follow ups. Answers any lingering questions and provides any materials family may need, i.e. calendar, community service placements, etc.
