Computing Your High School Grade Point Average (GPA)

Important to Note:

- 1) While high school credits earned in middle school DO count towards high school graduation requirements, they DO NOT count toward the calculation of the high school GPA.
- 2) Quarter and semester grades are only used in final grade calculation.
- 3) Only final grades are used in GPA calculation.
- 4) ALL final grades count in senior year cumulative grade point average meaning that grades earned in your freshman year weigh equally as heavy as grades earned in sophomore and junior years. This is very important to know for future preparation for applying to colleges.
- 5) All earned credits and grades are permanent.
 - *Re-taking a failed course adds an additional earned grade and credit to your transcript, but does not replace the previous grade.
 - *Re-taking a passed course for a better grade adds an additional earned grade to your transcript, but does not replace the previous grade.
