When?

Capital Area Teen Court hearings are held the 1st & 3rd Tuesdays of each month in Wake County. Cases are heard from 6:00-8:00 pm

Where?

Capital Area Teen Court is held at the Old Wake County Courthouse in downtown Raleigh. Enter in on 316 Fayetteville St.

Why?

As a Teen Court volunteer, you can make a positive impact on your community and many young adults who need positive role models. For practicing attorneys and judges are you able to work one-on-one with youth who are aspiring to fulfill your position in the future! Many roles need to be filled such as Mentor Attorneys, Judges, Exit Interviewers, and Jury Monitors!

Capital Area Teen Court is a diversion program for youth in middle & high school who commit their 1st misdemeanor offense. If the offender is eligible, s/he may choose to participate in teen court instead of going through traditional court proceedings.

In Teen Court, all of the attorneys, bailiffs and jurors are youth in middle or high school who volunteers to participate in the program. Teen Court hears *REAL* cases for charges such as larceny, affray, assault, property damage, and possession of drugs or alcohol.
