- Tonight it will be very cold and you should stay inside and seek shelter to protect yourself.
- These are the places in Raleigh where you can stay inside, even if they are usually full.
- White Flag is called when the temperature will be 32 degrees or below or 38 degrees and there is expected precipitation.
