What can YOU do?

Need Community Service?

- ⇒ **Juror**—Member of the jury (volunteer or former defendant) responsible for listening intently to case details and deciding appropriate sentence
- ⇒ **Jury Foreperson**—Responsible for leading the deliberation process once the jury has been sequestered and reporting to the judge; alternates every case
- ⇒ **Bailiff**—Calls the courtroom to order, announces case & case number, swears in witnesses, and assists the judge throughout the court proceedings (can be a member of the jury)
- ⇒ **Defense Attorney**—Represents the offender and argues for the minimum sentencing
- ⇒ **Prosecuting Attorney**—Represents the State (our community) and seeks adequate punishment for the offender; does not have to argue for the maximum sentencing
